

PUBLIC FORUM ON INDEPENDENT MONITOR FINALISTS FOR THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT CONSENT DECREE

The Office of the Illinois Attorney General and the City of Chicago are hosting two public forum sessions with finalist teams for the role of independent monitor of the consent decree for the Chicago Police Department. The public forum will be an opportunity for the finalist teams to make presentations and respond to questions and feedback from members of the public.

The federal judge overseeing the Attorney General's lawsuit that brought about the police consent decree will make the final selection on the independent monitor. The Attorney General's Office and the City will make recommendations about a final monitor to the federal judge for his consideration.
